

ARTICLE VI TEAMS

E. MISSIONS AND BENEVOLENCE TEAM

Section 1. The Missions and Benevolence Team shall consist of five (5) members. The Chairperson of the Missions and Benevolence Team will be selected from the Leadership Council from its membership. The remaining four (4) members will be appointed by the Leadership Council at the first Leadership Council meeting of each calendar year. The Missions and Benevolence Team will select its own Vice-Chairperson, Treasurer and Secretary.

Section 2. The Missions and Benevolence Team shall organize an annual Faith Promise Convention. The purpose of this convention is to raise faith pledges from the congregation separate from the regular church budget to support local, national and world missions. This organizing effort shall include:

- 1) picking a date for the convention
- 2) finding a guest speaker(s) for the convention
- 3) setting a pledge goal for the convention
- 4) formulating a proposed one year budget for the distribution of the faith pledges
- 5) publicizing the convention.

Section 3. It shall each month distribute incoming faith pledges according to its proposed annual budget, after first adjusting this budget to reflect the actual amount of Faith Promise Pledges that were made.

Section 4. It shall acquaint itself with the circumstances of those who are properly objects of concern and shall distribute wisely the funds of the church set aside for this purpose. It shall serve as the Flower Committee of the church and shall keep the pastor informed of those in need or ill in our fellowship.
